Its goal is to set before the believer one of the major aspect of God's plan for the ages.

A Crash Course Bible Study Methods. This session will present a very practical method for how to study the Bible. It will not address Bible interpretation or hermeneutics. It will present the inductive Bible study method, word studies, the use of common Bible study tools, charting, and other tools the believer can immediately put to use in building sound Bible study habits for years to come.
